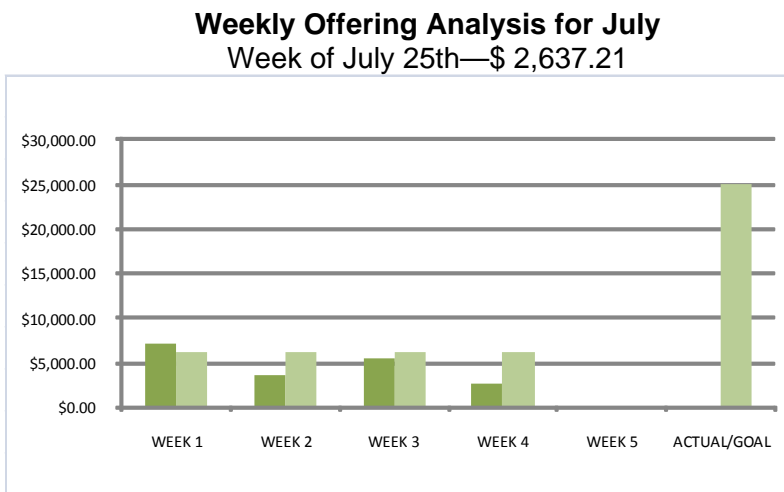
Mass in Parish Hall:
